MAYBA WAREHOUSE GUIDELINES



Batting Cage Use:

- Both hitter and pitcher/feeder must wear a helmet while in batting cage.
- Potential hitters can only sign their names up once; when they've completed their hitting session, they must erase their name and can replace it at the bottom of the list.
- The soft-toss/tee hitting area at the west end of the Warehouse will not always be available.
- A hitter's session in the cage will be limited to 20-25 swings.

Throwing area use:

- Only three throwing lanes will be allowed in the "play area".
- Pitching & catching practice is encouraged but all participants in a "crouch" position must wear a protective mask and helmet (provided by MAYBA).
- Please limit your throwing sessions to 10 minutes so that everybody gets a chance to throw.

General Guidelines:

- Safety needs to be the highest priority!
- Horse play and/or aggressive behavior will not be tolerated.
- Avoid bringing large equipment bags to the Warehouse...space is limited!!
- Respect the facility and MAYBA staff; pick-up after yourself and absolutely no sunflower seeds!

I acknowledge these safety guidelines required for using the MAYBA Warehouse, and promise to abide by these rules. By not following the guidelines, I may be asked to leave the warehouse for that session, or for the rest of the season.
