Players Code of Conduct for all MAYBA Traveling Teams

1. Any misconduct which leads to ejection from the game.
 - A. Penalty: Immediate ejection from the game and the player must also sit out the next game as well.
 - B. Second Offense: Suspension from the team pending a review by the MAYBA board of directors
2. No taunting, hazing, or harassment of any kind directed toward teammates, coaches, opponents, umpires, or anyone else connected with the baseball experience. Penalties for such will be handled on an individual basis, pending the outcome of an investigation by a committee representing the MAYBA board and staff, but penalties ranging from suspension to complete removal from team participation are possible.
3. Players are expected to be in complete uniform at all times during baseball competition. This includes all game experience time, from arrival to departure from the field.
4. Players are subject to the Minnesota State High School League rules regarding the use of alcohol, tobacco and mood-altering drugs (other than prescription medications).
5. MAYBA reserves the right to, upon completion of an investigation of any incident involving misconduct, to levy a sanction which the members of the investigating committee deem as a proper and fitting sanction to the particular act of misconduct which took place.
